1. A “City on a Hill”

a. Pilgrims, Puritans and the Abrahamic Covenant

The Pilgrims and Puritans were fleeing the persecution of their faith in Europe. They had a belief that they were “the modern Israelites”, leaving Egypt. They believed they were the next generation of the “Children of Abraham”.

The Abrahamic Covenant, Abram Journeys to Egypt

Genesis 12: 1-3 Amplified Bible

1 Now [in Haran] the Lord had said to Abram, “Go away from your country,
And from your relatives
And from your father’s house,
To the land which I will show you;
²

And ^[a]I will make you a great nation,
And I will bless you [abundantly],
And make your name great (exalted, distinguished);
And you shall be a blessing [a source of great good to others];

And I will bless (do good for, benefit) those who bless you,
 And I will curse [that is, subject to My wrath and judgment] the one who curses (despises, dishonors, has contempt for) you.
 And in you all the families (nations) of the earth will be blessed."

Acts 3:25 Amplified Bible

25 You are the sons (descendants) of the prophets and [heirs] of the covenant which God made with your fathers, saying to Abraham, 'And in your seed (descendant) all the families of the earth shall be blessed.'

Exodus 19:5-6 Amplified Bible

5 Now therefore, if you will in fact obey My voice and keep My covenant (agreement), then you shall be My own special possession *and* treasure from among all peoples [of the world], for all the earth is Mine; **6** and you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation [set apart for My purpose].'

Those who settled in the New World envisioned their communities as a "city upon a hill," reflecting a profound sense of divine purpose and a covenantal relationship with God. This perspective is evident in several key writings and sermons from that era.

The Mayflower Compact (1620)

Before disembarking at Plymouth, the Pilgrims signed the Mayflower Compact, a foundational document expressing their intent to establish a community based on Christian principles:

"Having undertaken, for the Glory of God, and advancement of the Christian faith... a voyage to plant the first colony in the northern parts of Virginia..."

This compact reflects their commitment to a society grounded in their faith.

Puritan Covenant Theology

Puritans believed in a covenant with God, viewing their community as a chosen people tasked with creating a society that exemplified Christian virtues. This covenantal view is discussed in various historical analyses, such as:

"If they abided by this covenant, God would make them an example with the world—a 'city upon a hill.'"

John Winthrop's "A Model of Christian Charity" (1630)

The concept of America as a "city upon a hill" and a nation under God's covenant has been a recurring theme our nation's history. This vision reflects the belief that the United States was established with a divine purpose to exemplify righteousness and serve as a beacon to the world.

John Winthrop's Vision

In 1630, John Winthrop, a leading Puritan figure, delivered this sermon aboard the Arbella before reaching the Massachusetts Bay Colony. He emphasized the colony's role as an example to the world, stating:

"For we must consider that we shall be as a city upon a hill. The eyes of all people are upon us."

Winthrop's metaphor drew from Jesus' Sermon on the Mount, emphasizing the colony's role as an example of Christian charity and moral conduct. Winthrop warned that failing to uphold their covenant with God would lead to the colony becoming "a story and a byword through the world."

b. Faith and the Founding Fathers

The Pilgrim and Puritan era was the backdrop for the founding of the Republic for The United States of America. As with their Puritan and Pilgrim ancestry, they had learned to read from the bible in its original languages, Latin, Greek, Hebrew, etc. Most of the United States' Founding Fathers were true Bond Servants of Christ and expressed their faith in and reliance on God, specifically through references to Jesus Christ, in their writings and speeches. Here are several notable examples:

George Washington

First President of the United States and "Father of His Country":

- In a personal prayer, Washington wrote:

"Bless, O Lord, the whole race of mankind and let the world be filled with the knowledge of Thee and Thy son, Jesus Christ."

John Adams

Signer of the Declaration of Independence and Second President of the United States:

- Reflecting on the principles of the nation, Adams stated:

"The general principles on which the fathers achieved independence were the general principles of Christianity."

John Witherspoon

Signer of the Declaration of Independence:

- In a sermon, Witherspoon urged:

"I entreat you in the most earnest manner to believe in Jesus Christ, for there is no salvation in any other."

Patrick Henry

Ratifier of the U.S. Constitution:

- Emphasizing the nation's Christian foundations, Henry declared:

"It cannot be emphasized too strongly or too often that this great nation was founded, not by religion (faith)ists, but by Christians; not on religion (faith)s, but on the gospel of Jesus Christ."

Benjamin Rush

Signer of the Declaration of Independence and Ratifier of the U.S. Constitution:

- Discussing the gospel's guidance, Rush wrote:

"The gospel of Jesus Christ prescribes the wisest rules for just conduct in every situation of life."

John Jay

First Chief Justice of the United States:

- On the selection of leaders, Jay advised:

"Providence (God) has given to our people the choice of their rulers, and it is the duty, as well as the privilege and interest of our Christian nation to select and prefer Christians for their rulers."

Thomas Jefferson

Principal author of the Declaration of Independence and third President of the United States:

- Jefferson held complex views on Christianity. He admired Jesus' teachings but was critical of organized religion (faith) and certain Christian doctrines. In a letter to Benjamin Rush in 1803, he wrote:

"I am a Christian, in the only sense in which [Jesus] wished any one to be; sincerely attached to his doctrines, in preference to all others."

- Jefferson compiled "The Life and Morals of Jesus of Nazareth," often referred to as the "Jefferson Bible," in which he extracted Jesus' teachings, omitting supernatural aspects. This work reflects his appreciation for Jesus' moral teachings while distancing himself from traditional Christian beliefs.

Benjamin Franklin

Renowned polymath and a Founding Father:

- Franklin's religious views evolved over time. In his later years, he expressed a belief in God and the moral teachings of Jesus. In a letter to Ezra Stiles, President of Yale College, dated March 9, 1790, Franklin stated:

"As to Jesus of Nazareth, my Opinion of whom you particularly desire, I think the System of Morals and his Religion (faith), as he left them to us, the best the World ever saw or is likely to see."

Alexander Hamilton

Co-author of the Federalist Papers and first Secretary of the Treasury:

- In his later years, Hamilton sought solace in Christianity. Before his death, he requested communion, stating:

"I have a tender reliance on the mercy of the Almighty, through the merits of the Lord Jesus Christ."

Charles Carroll

Signer of the Declaration of Independence:

- Reflecting on his faith, Carroll wrote:

"On the mercy of my Redeemer I rely for salvation and on His merits; not on the works I have done in obedience to His precepts."

Samuel Adams

Signer of the Declaration of Independence and known as the "Father of the American Revolution":

- In his will, Adams expressed his faith:

"I rely upon the merits of Jesus Christ for a pardon of all my sins."

John Hancock

Signer of the Declaration of Independence:

- In a proclamation, Hancock stated:

"That the kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ may be established in peace and righteousness among all the nations of the earth."

Roger Sherman

Signer of both the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution:

- Sherman professed:

"I believe that there is one only living and true God...and that He was revealed to mankind in the person of Jesus Christ."

Gouverneur Morris

Signer of the U.S. Constitution:

- Morris emphasized the importance of religion (faith):

"Religion (faith) is the only solid basis of good morals; therefore education should teach the precepts of religion (faith), and the duties of man towards God."

"Only a virtuous people are capable of freedom. As nations become corrupt and vicious, they have more need of masters."

— *Letter to Messrs. the Abbes Chalut and Arnoux, April 17, 1787*

These quotes illustrate the personal faith and reliance on Jesus Christ expressed by most if not all Founding Fathers in their writings and statements. These statements reflect the personal beliefs of these individuals and their perspectives on the role of Christianity in the early United States of America.

- c. **Further, many Pilgrims, Puritans and Founding Fathers believed the Republic represented the Stone Kingdom spoken of in the book of Daniel**

Daniel 2 Amplified Bible

The King's Forgotten Dream

2 In the second year (604 B.C.) of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams which troubled *and* disturbed his spirit and [interfered with] his ability to sleep. ² Then the king gave a command to call the magicians, the enchanters, the sorcerers, and the ^[a] Chaldeans to tell the king his dreams. So they came in and stood before the king. ³ The king said to them, “I had a dream, and my spirit is troubled *and* anxious to know the [content and meaning of the] dream.”

The Secret Is Revealed to Daniel, The Divine Kingdom (Authority)

⁴⁴ In the days of those [final ten] kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed, nor will its sovereignty be left for another people; but **it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it will stand forever.** ⁴⁵ Just as **you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands** and that it crushed the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver and the gold, the great God has revealed to the king what will take place in the future; so the dream is true and its interpretation is trustworthy.”

2. One Nation Under God

a. The Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the Republic for the United States of America, more evidence of divine inspiration and reliance

In the months and years after the Revolutionary War, as our founding fathers labored to create a government “Of The People, By The People, For The People”, their faith and scripture, continued to guide them.

Isaiah 9:6-7 Amplified Bible

6

For to us a Child shall be born, to us a Son shall be given;
And the government shall be upon His shoulder,
And His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
7

There shall be no end to the increase of His government and of peace,
[He shall rule] on the throne of David and over his kingdom,
To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness
From that time forward and forevermore.
The zeal of the Lord of hosts will accomplish this.

As Born Again Christians and Bond Servants of Christ, indwelt with the Holy Spirit, they believed that Isaiah was speaking of this “Of The People, By The People, For The People” form of government, one that would only work for a people and nation of faith. They clearly reasoned that **with the Holy Spirit in them, the government resting on “The Peoples” shoulders meant that is was resting on “His, Christ’s” shoulders.** This is made clear in our Declaration of Independence, the most important document of our nation as it guided the creation of our equally important Constitution. Here are the first few lines:

IN CONGRESS, JULY 4, 1776

The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America

“When in the Course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the **Laws of Nature** and of Nature's **God** entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that **all men are created equal**, that **they are endowed by their Creator** with certain unalienable Rights that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.”

b. The Constitution of the United States of America, yet more evidence of divine inspiration and foundational necessity

Preamble

We the People of the United States, in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America.

And the same holds true for the Bill of Rights, the first amendments to the constitution. The first focus was on faith, what they used to call religion (faith):

c. The Bill of Rights (1791)

Amendment I – Freedom of Religion (faith), Speech, Press, Assembly, and Petition

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion (faith), or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

Our Founding Fathers were very serious about this as evidenced in their additional writings and journals:

John Adams famously stated:

"Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other."

This quote comes from a letter Adams wrote to the Massachusetts Militia on October 11, 1798. In this letter, he emphasized that the success of the American system of government depended on the virtue and morality of its citizens, reinforcing the idea that freedom and self-governance require a foundation of religious and ethical principles.

John Adams articulated his views on the responsibilities of the clergy in his 1774 essay, "Novanglus," where he wrote:

"It is the duty of the clergy to accommodate their discourses to the times, to preach against such sins as are most prevalent, and recommend such virtues as are most wanted."

In this context, Adams emphasized that clergy should address contemporary issues by condemning widespread sins and promoting necessary virtues, thereby guiding their congregations in navigating the moral challenges of their era.

In March 1854, the House Judiciary Committee of the U.S. Congress issued a report addressing the role of religion (faith) in government institutions, particularly concerning the appointment of chaplains. The committee emphasized the foundational importance of Christianity in American society, stating:

"The great, vital, and conservative element in our system is the belief of our people in the pure doctrines and divine truths of the Gospel of Jesus Christ."

"Had the people, during the Revolution, had a suspicion of any attempt to war against Christianity, that Revolution would have been strangled in its cradle... In this age, there can be no substitute for Christianity... That was the religion (faith) of the founders of the republic and they expected it to remain the religion (faith) of their descendants."

This declaration underscored the committee's view that the nation's institutions and governance were deeply rooted in Christian principles.

3. The Government is upon His/Our Shoulders

Isaiah 9:6-7 Amplified Bible

6

For to us a Child shall be born, to us a Son shall be given;
And the government shall be upon His shoulder,
And His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

The Pilgrims, Puritans and our Founding Fathers well understood that the only way a government of the people by the people, for the people could work is if the people believed in Jesus Christ and had received the Holy Spirit, so that His laws were written on our hearts, and hence, the government was then as prophesied, “Upon His Shoulders” via our shoulders.

4. We were intended to be and are, a Republic, not a Democracy

A quote often attributed to Benjamin Franklin is:

"Democracy is two wolves and a lamb voting on what to have for lunch. Liberty is a well-armed lamb contesting the vote!"

Franklin often expressed concerns about pure democracy and the importance of protecting individual rights.

On Democracy vs. a Republic:

Franklin recognized the importance of a well-structured government over pure democracy. When asked what kind of government had been created at the Constitutional Convention, he famously replied:

"A Republic, if you can keep it."

— Attributed to Franklin in notes by James McHenry, 1787

The difference between a **Republic** (as Franklin referred to it) and a **Democracy** lies in the structure and function of government, particularly in how laws are made and how power is distributed.

1. A Republic (as Franklin referred to it)

- A **republic** is a form of government in which the people elect representatives to make laws and govern on their behalf.
- It is based on the **rule of law**, meaning that even the majority cannot override fundamental rights protected by a constitution.
- It emphasizes **checks and balances**, separation of powers, and protections for **individual rights** against government overreach.
- The U.S. Constitution established a **constitutional republic**, meaning the government operates under a set framework (the Constitution) that limits its powers and protects freedoms.

Franklin's famous response: *"A Republic, if you can keep it."* – This meant that maintaining the system required an informed and virtuous citizenry.

2. A Pure Democracy

- In a **democracy**, laws and decisions are made directly by the majority, typically through direct voting.
- The majority has full control, which can lead to **mob rule** or oppression of minorities if no constitutional protections exist.
- Democracies can lead to instability because public opinion can shift quickly, leading to radical changes in law or governance.

Key Difference: Rule of Law vs. Majority Rule

- A **democracy** is based on **majority rule**—the people directly decide policies, and whatever the majority wants becomes law.
- A **republic** is based on **rule of law**—elected representatives govern within the framework of a constitution that protects individual rights, even against the will of the majority.

Why Did Franklin Favor a Republic Over a Democracy?

The Founding Fathers, including Franklin, were wary of **pure democracy** because history showed that it often led to **mob rule** and the erosion of individual rights. Instead, they designed the U.S. as a **constitutional republic** to ensure a stable system where:

- **Laws are made by representatives**, not directly by the people.
- **The government's power is limited** by the Constitution.
- **Minority rights are protected** against the tyranny of the majority.

Franklin was obviously not alone in such thinking

John Adams echoed Franklin's concerns, saying:

"Democracy never lasts long. It soon wastes, exhausts, and murders itself. There was never a democracy that did not commit suicide."

This is why the U.S. was founded as a **republic**, ensuring both popular representation and the protection of God-given rights

5. Prophetic Warnings from George Washington's Inaugural and Farewell addresses to the Nation

First Inaugural Address (April 30, 1789):

In his inaugural address on April 30, 1789, President Washington expressed his humility and sense of duty upon assuming the presidency:

"Fellow Citizens of the Senate and the House of Representatives. Among the vicissitudes incident to life, no event could have filled me with greater anxieties than that of which the notification was transmitted by your order, and received on the 14th day of the present month."

Washington acknowledged the nation's dependence on divine Providence (God):

"The propitious smiles of Heaven can never be expected on a nation that disregards the eternal rules of order and right, which Heaven itself has ordained."

He acknowledged the guiding hand of God in the nation's affairs:

"No people can be bound to acknowledge and adore the Invisible Hand which conducts the affairs of men more than the people of the United States."

Washington also emphasized the importance of the Constitution and the principles of free government:

"The preservation of the sacred fire of liberty, and the destiny of the republican model of government, are justly considered as deeply, perhaps as finally staked on the experiment entrusted to the hands of the American people."

Farewell Address (September 19, 1796):

In his Farewell Address, President Washington announced his decision not to seek a third term and offered advice to the nation. He warned against the dangers of political parties:

"The alternate domination of one faction over another, sharpened by the spirit of revenge, natural to party dissension... is itself a frightful despotism."

He cautioned against permanent foreign alliances:

"It is our true policy to steer clear of permanent alliances with any portion of the foreign world."

Washington also stressed the importance of religion (faith) and morality:

"Of all the dispositions and habits which lead to political prosperity, religion (faith) and morality are indispensable supports."

President George Washington offered several warnings to the American people to preserve the nation's unity and integrity. He cautioned against the dangers of political factions and the potential for individuals to exploit the government for personal gain. He stated:

"However [political parties] may now and then answer popular ends, they are likely... to become potent engines, by which cunning, ambitious, and unprincipled men (Satanists) will be enabled to subvert the power of the people and to usurp for themselves the reins of government."

These excerpts reflect Washington's concerns about internal threats to the nation's stability, including the potential for individuals driven by personal ambition to undermine the Republic and the Constitution.

6. The necessity of God in Government, not a Government ordained Religion (Faith)

The concept of separating religion (faith) from government was a significant concern for America's Founding Fathers and early religious leaders. Their writings reflect a commitment to ensuring religious freedom while preventing governmental endorsement or establishment of religion (faith). The following writings are quite clear. The intentions of the Founding Fathers and Clergy of the time were keenly aware of government's propensity to interfere with the church and to use it against the people. They wanted to prevent government from interfering with the church and individual faith. They did not however in any way want to limit God's influence in government or politics directly, via the church or believers, specifically Christians as they nearly all were.

Keeping the government out of the church

Thomas Jefferson

In his 1802 letter to the Danbury Baptist Association, Jefferson articulated his understanding of the First Amendment:

"I contemplate with sovereign reverence that act of the whole American people which declared that their legislature should 'make no law respecting an establishment of religion (faith), or prohibiting the free exercise thereof,' thus building a wall of separation between Church & State."

This metaphor of a "wall of separation" has become foundational in discussions about church-state relations.

James Madison

Known as the "Father of the Constitution," Madison was a strong advocate for religious liberty. In his 1785 "Memorial and Remonstrance against Religious Assessments," he argued against state-supported religion (faith):

"The Religion (faith) then of every man must be left to the conviction and conscience of every man; and it is the right of every man to exercise it as these may dictate."

Madison emphasized that religion (faith) is a matter of personal conscience and should not be influenced by government.

Roger Williams

As the founder of Rhode Island, Williams was an early proponent of religious freedom. He believed in a clear distinction between church and state to protect the purity of the church:

"An authentic Christian church would be possible only if there was 'a wall or hedge of separation' between the 'wilderness of the world' and 'the garden of the church.'"

Williams feared that government involvement would corrupt the church.

John Leland

A prominent Baptist minister, Leland was a staunch advocate for religious liberty. He wrote:

"The notion of a Christian commonwealth should be exploded forever... Government should protect every man in thinking and speaking freely, and see that one does not abuse another."

Leland's views influenced the inclusion of religious freedom protections in the Constitution.

These writings collectively underscore the early American commitment to religious freedom and the principle that government should not interfere in religious matters, ensuring a "wall of separation" between church and state.

Keeping God in government and politics

The Founding Fathers and early American clergy recognized the importance of religion (faith) in fostering morality and virtue, which they deemed essential for the republic's success. While advocating for the separation of church and state to ensure religious freedom, they also emphasized the necessity of religious principles in public life.

George Washington

In his 1796 Farewell Address, President Washington underscored the significance of religion (faith) and morality:

"Of all the dispositions and habits which lead to political prosperity, religion (faith) and morality are indispensable supports. In vain would that man claim the tribute of patriotism who should labor to subvert these great pillars of human happiness."

Washington believed that national morality could not prevail without religious principles, viewing them as foundational to the nation's well-being.

John Adams

President John Adams highlighted the reliance of the American government on a moral and religious populace:

"Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious People. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other."

Adams asserted that the constitutional framework was designed for citizens guided by moral and religious values, implying that the system's success depended on such virtues.

Benjamin Franklin

Although often associated with deist beliefs, Franklin acknowledged the role of divine Providence (God) in human affairs. During the Constitutional Convention of 1787, he stated:

"I have lived, Sir, a long time, and the longer I live, the more convincing proofs I see of this truth—that God governs in the affairs of men."

Franklin advocated for daily prayers during the convention, emphasizing the necessity of seeking divine guidance in governmental deliberations.

Early American Clergy

Clergymen in the early republic often participated in political discourse, emphasizing the role of religion (faith) in public life. They argued that religious principles were vital for maintaining social order and guiding the nation's moral compass. For instance, many sermons of the era linked religious virtue to civic responsibility, reinforcing the idea that a self-governing people required a foundation in religious ethics.

Charles Grandison Finney, a prominent 19th-century evangelist and leader of the Second Great Awakening, emphasized the critical role of the church in engaging with political matters. He believed that Christians had a duty to influence politics to uphold moral and righteous standards.

In his "Lectures on Revivals of Religion (faith)" (1835), Finney stated:

"The Church must take right ground in regard to politics... Politics are a part of a religion (faith) in such a country as this, and Christians must do their duty to the country as part of their duty to God... God will bless or curse this nation, according to the course Christians take in politics."

Finney argued that political engagement was an extension of religious duty, asserting that the nation's fate was intertwined with the moral actions of its Christian citizens.

He further emphasized the responsibility of the pulpit in shaping the nation's moral and political landscape:

"If there is a decay of conscience, the pulpit is responsible for it. If the public press lacks moral discernment, the pulpit is responsible for it. If the church is degenerate and worldly, the pulpit is responsible for it. If the world loses its interest in Christianity, the pulpit is responsible for it. If Satan rules in our halls of legislation, the pulpit is responsible for it. If our politics become so corrupt that the very foundations of our government are ready to fall away, the pulpit is responsible for it."

This passage underscores Finney's belief that religious leaders held significant accountability for the nation's ethical and political direction.

In his writings, Finney also addressed the importance of voting:

"The time has come that Christians must vote for honest men, and take consistent ground in politics, or the Lord will curse them."

He urged Christians to support candidates of integrity, linking political participation to divine favor or disfavor.

Through these exhortations, Finney advocated for active Christian involvement in politics, viewing it as a moral obligation integral to both religious faith and the nation's well-being.

In summary, while the Founding Fathers and early American clergy advocated for a separation between church and state to protect religious freedom, they also believed that religion (faith) played a crucial role in promoting the morality and virtue necessary in the nation's government and then for the people's prosperity.

7. In the beginning, we were much blessed

"When the people find that they can vote themselves money, that will herald the end of the republic." (The Satanists well understood this)

Overt slavery (Africans) was the original weapon of choice to divide us, pull us away from God and break our national covenant with Him. Who's weapon? The Satanists of the Vatican, Jesuits, the Rothschilds, Zionists, Illuminati and other secret organizations. They needed the Republic to fall so they could enslave Americans like they had most of the rest of the world. They knew this "city of light on a hill" and the freedom and liberty of the people, protected by its unique, God inspired constitution, represented a direct deterrent to their satanic agenda of complete enslavement of humanity.

As in more modern times with JFK and his Satanist VP Johnson, Regan and his Satanist VP Bush, and their assassination attempts on sitting presidents, the Satanists went to work. Presidents Taylor and Harrison were assassinated via arsenic poisoning so that their Satanist VPs could bring in more slave friendly states and drive the nation toward civil war which would destroy the Republic. They similarly tried to poison Buchanan but, he figured it out and survived. The Satanists ultimately lost the civil war they started but, at the beginning of the war, Lincoln had to suspend the Republic and the Satanists assassinated him quickly after the war, before he could restore it. That left the door open for the Satanists to deceive us into the illegal act of 1871 in which they modified our constitution and moved us from our precious Republic to the US Corporation under the guise of Civil War debt necessity. Remember, the Satanist Bank of England funded both sides of the war they incited. (Just like the Patriot Act, the NSA, etc. after 911 which they staged, so that they could spy on the American people, the "terrorist" enemy. We were willingly giving away yet more of our freedoms. Their playbook never changes.) President Andrew Jackson fought hard against them for which they tried to assassinate him as well so, his Satanist VP Calhoun could step in. Jackson survived but, Calhoun and Satanist henchmen Biddle eventually prevailed anyway, orchestrating events behind the scenes. The below communication between the Satanist bankers in Europe to the Satanist bankers in America shows how they used the Civil War they'd incited to their advantage to destroy the Republic and further enslave humanity.

The "Hazard Circular" is a document issued in 1862, by the Bank of England to Satanic American banking interests. It discusses strategies to control American industry and labor by manipulating the money supply.

The text of the "Hazard Circular" is as follows:

"Slavery is likely to be abolished by the war power and chattel slavery destroyed. This, I and my European friends are in favor of, for slavery is but the owning of labor and carries with it the care of the laborer, while the European plan, led on by England, is capital control of labor by controlling wages. This can be done by controlling the money. The great debt that capitalists will

see to it is made out of the war must be used to control the value of money. To accomplish this, bonds must be used as a banking basis. We are now waiting for the Secretary of the Treasury to make this recommendation to Congress. It will not do to allow the greenback, as it is called, to circulate as money any length of time, as we cannot control that."

During the Civil War, Abraham Lincoln recognized the nation's covenant with God. In his Second Inaugural Address on March 4, 1865, he stated:

"Fondly do we hope, fervently do we pray, that this mighty scourge of war may speedily pass away. Yet, if God wills that it continue until all the wealth piled by the bondsman's two hundred and fifty years of unrequited toil shall be sunk, and until every drop of blood drawn with the lash shall be paid by another drawn with the sword, as was said three thousand years ago, so still it must be said 'the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether.'"

Lincoln's acknowledgment of divine judgment reflects the nation's covenantal relationship with God.

Before the Civil War, Lincoln had to stay the Republic with the intent to re-establish it afterwards. As usual, the Satanists (Jesuits), assassinated him before he could do so, enabling them to further damage the Republic or, "The City on a Hill".

The Satanists (Jesuits) passed the illegal Act of 1871, which created the US Corporation, owned by the Bank of England (Vatican front). Under the US Corporation, morality was sent into its more rapid decline and big business money became the influence and objective of all things political, rather than God, faith and "The People".

The Satanists discarded the intent of The Declaration of Independence. They began to take God out of government, business, schools and pretty much everything else.

Prior to the Civil War, church services were regularly held in the Capital Building of The Republic. In 1954, Jesuit Satanist Senator Lyndon Johnson introduced the bill to create 501c3 tax exempt religious organizations. This was essentially a gag order for churches. In exchange for church and parishioner tax exemption, God was taken out of government and government was put in control of religion and the church, exactly the opposite of Founding Father intent.

In 1962 the Supreme Court of the US Corporation made it illegal to have teacher led prayer in classrooms.

Our founding fathers learned to read from their bibles. In 1963, the Supreme Court of the US Corporation made it illegal to have organized bible reading in public schools.

Soon thereafter, also in the 1960s, the Supreme Court of the US Corporation made abortion legal via the contrived Roe v. Wade case.

In 1963 the Jesuit Satanists assassinated John F. 9. With our steady drift from God, we have become a cursed Nation

Deuteronomy 28:15-68 Amplified Bible

Consequences of Disobedience

15 “But it shall come about, if you do not listen to *and* obey the voice of the Lord your God, being careful to do all His commandments and His statutes which I am commanding you today, then all these curses will come upon you and overtake you:

16 “You *will be* cursed in the city and cursed in the field.

17 “Your basket and your kneading bowl *will be* cursed.

18 “The offspring of your body and the produce of your land, the offspring of your herd and the young of your flock *will be* cursed.

19 “You *will be* cursed when you come in and you *will be* cursed when you go out.

20 “The Lord will send upon you curses, confusion, and rebuke in everything that you undertake to do, until you are destroyed, perishing quickly because of the evil of your deeds, because you have ^[d]turned away from Me. **21** The Lord will make the pestilence *and* plague cling to you until He has consumed *and* eliminated you from the land which you are entering to possess. **22** The Lord will strike you with consumption [causing you to waste away] and with fever and with inflammation and with fiery heat and with the sword and with blight and with mildew [on your crops]; and they will pursue you until you perish. **23** The heaven which is over your head shall be bronze [giving no rain and blocking all prayers], and the earth which is under you, iron [hard to plow and yielding no produce]. **24** The Lord will make the rain of your land powder and dust; from heaven it will come down on you until you are destroyed.

25 “The Lord will cause you to be defeated before your enemies; you will go out against them one way, but flee before them seven ways, and you will be *an example of* terror to all the kingdoms of the earth [when they see your destruction]. **26** Your carcasses will be food for all the birds of the sky and the beasts of the earth, and there will be no one to frighten them away.

27 “The Lord will strike you with the boils of Egypt and with tumors and with the scab and the itch that you cannot heal. **28** The Lord will strike you with madness and with blindness and with bewilderment of heart *and* mind; **29** and you will be groping at noon [in broad daylight], just as the blind grope in the darkness, and nothing you do will prosper; but you will only be oppressed *and* exploited and robbed continually, with no one to save you. **30** You will be pledged to marry a wife, but another man will be intimate with her [before you]; you will build a house, but you will not live in it; you will plant a vineyard, but you will not use its fruit. **31** Your ox will be slaughtered before your eyes, but you will not eat any of it; your donkey will be torn away from you, and it will not be returned to you; your sheep will be given to your enemies, and you will have no one to save you. **32** Your sons and daughters will be given to another people, while your eyes look on and long for them continually; but there will be nothing you can do. **33** A people whom you do not know will eat the produce of your land and all the products of your labors, and you will never be anything but oppressed *and* exploited and crushed continually. **34** You shall be driven mad by the sight of ^[e]the things you see. **35** The Lord will strike you on the knees and on the legs with sore boils that you cannot heal, from the sole of your foot to the crown of your head. **36** The Lord will bring you and your king, whom you appoint over you, to a nation which you and your fathers have never known; there you will [be forced to] serve other gods, [lifeless gods of] wood and stone. **37** And you will become a horror, a proverb [a mere object lesson], and a taunt [a derisive joke] among all the people to which the Lord drives you.

38 “You will bring out a great quantity of seed to the field, but you will gather in little, because the locusts will consume it. **39** You will plant vineyards and cultivate them, but you will not drink the wine or gather *the grapes*, because the worm will eat them. **40** You will have olive trees throughout your territory but you will not ^[f]anoint yourselves with the oil, because your olives

will drop off. ⁴¹ You will have sons and daughters, but they will not be yours [for long], because they will go into captivity. ⁴² The cricket will take possession of all your trees and the produce of your ground. ⁴³ The stranger who lives among you will rise above you higher and higher, and you will go down lower and lower. ⁴⁴ He will lend to you [out of his affluence], but you will not lend to him [because of your poverty]; he will be the head, and you the tail.

⁴⁵ “So all these curses will come on you and pursue you and overtake you until you are destroyed, because you would not obey the voice of the Lord your God by keeping His commandments and His statutes which He has commanded you. ⁴⁶ They will be a sign and a wonder to you and your descendants forever.

⁴⁷ “Because you did not serve the Lord your God with a heart full of joy and gladness for the abundance of all things [with which He blessed you], ⁴⁸ you will therefore serve your enemies whom the Lord sends against you, in hunger and in thirst, in nakedness and in lack of all things; and He will put an iron yoke [of slavery] on your neck until He has destroyed you.

⁴⁹ “The Lord will bring a nation against you from far away, from the end of the earth, [as swift] as the eagle swoops down [to attack], a nation whose language you will not understand, ⁵⁰ a ^[g]defiant nation who will ^[h]have no respect for the old, nor show favor to the young, ⁵¹ and it will eat the offspring of your herd and the produce of your ground until you are destroyed, who will leave you no grain, new wine, or oil, nor the offspring of your herd or the young of your flock until they have caused you to perish. ⁵² They will besiege you in all your cities until your high and fortified walls in which you trusted come down throughout your land; and they will besiege you in all your cities throughout your land which the Lord your God has given you. ⁵³ Then you will eat the offspring of your own body [to avoid starvation], the flesh of your sons and daughters whom the Lord your God has given you, during the siege and the misery by which your enemy will oppress you. ⁵⁴ The man who is most refined and well-bred among you ^[i]will be cruel *and* hostile toward his brother and toward ^[i]the wife he cherishes and toward the rest of his children who remain, ⁵⁵ so that he will not give *even* one of them any of the flesh of his children ^[k]which he will eat, ^[l]because he has nothing else left, during the siege and the misery by which your enemy will oppress you in all your cities. ⁵⁶ The most refined and well-bred woman among you, who would not venture to set the sole of her foot on the ground because she is so delicate and pampered, ^[m]will be cruel *and* hostile toward ^[n]the husband she cherishes and toward her son and daughter, ⁵⁷ and toward her afterbirth that comes from between her legs and toward the children whom she bears; for she will eat them secretly for lack of anything else, during the siege and the misery by which your enemy will oppress you in your cities.

⁵⁸ “If you are not careful to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, to fear *and* honor with reverence this glorious and awesome name, the Lord your God, ⁵⁹ then the Lord will bring extraordinary plagues on you and your descendants, even severe and lasting plagues, and miserable and chronic sicknesses. ⁶⁰ Moreover, He will bring on you all the diseases of Egypt of which you were afraid, and they will cling to you. ⁶¹ Also the Lord will bring on you every sickness and every plague which is not written in this book of this law, until you are destroyed. ⁶² Because you did not obey the voice of the Lord your God, you who were as numerous as the stars of heaven shall be left few in number. ⁶³ It shall come about that just as the Lord delighted over you to make you prosper and multiply, so the Lord will delight over you

to bring you to ruin and destruction; and you will be ^[o]uprooted [violently] from the land which you are entering to possess. ⁶⁴ And the Lord will scatter you among all the nations, from one end of the earth to the other; and there you will [be forced to] serve other gods, [lifeless gods of] wood and stone, which neither you nor your fathers have known. ⁶⁵ Among those nations you will find no peace (rest), and there will be no resting place for the sole of your foot; but there the Lord will give you a trembling heart, failing eyes, and a despairing soul. ⁶⁶ Your life will hang in doubt before you; night and day you will be filled with anxiety and have no assurance of living. ⁶⁷ In the morning you will say, 'I wish it were evening!' and in the evening you will say, 'I wish it were morning!'—because of the dread in your heart with which you tremble, and because of the sight of your eyes which you will see. ⁶⁸ The Lord will bring you back to Egypt in ships, by the way about which I said to you, 'You will never see it again!' And there you will offer yourselves for sale to your enemies as male and female slaves, but there will be no one to buy you.

Romans 1:18-32 Amplified Bible

Unbelief and Its Consequences

¹⁸ For [God does not overlook sin and] the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who in their wickedness suppress *and* stifle the truth, ¹⁹ because that which is known about God is evident within them [in their inner consciousness], for God made it evident to them. ²⁰ For ever since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through His workmanship [all His creation, the wonderful things that He has made], so that they [who fail to believe and trust in Him] are without excuse *and* without defense. ²¹ For even though ^[a]they knew God [as the Creator], they did not ^[b]honor Him as God or give thanks [for His wondrous creation]. On the contrary, they became worthless in their thinking [godless, with pointless reasoning, and silly speculations], and their foolish heart was darkened. ²² Claiming to be wise, they became fools, ²³ and exchanged the glory *and* majesty *and* excellence of the immortal God for ^[c]an image [worthless idols] in the shape of mortal man and birds and four-footed animals and reptiles.

²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their own hearts to [sexual] impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them [abandoning them to the degrading power of sin], ²⁵ because [by choice] they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen.

²⁶ For this reason God gave them over to degrading *and* vile passions; for their women exchanged the natural function for that which is unnatural [a function contrary to nature], ²⁷ and in the same way also the men turned away from the natural function of the woman and were consumed with their desire toward one another, men with men committing shameful acts and in return receiving in their own bodies the inevitable *and* appropriate penalty for their wrongdoing.

²⁸ And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God *or* consider Him worth knowing [as their Creator], God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do things which are improper *and* repulsive, ²⁹ until they were filled (permeated, saturated) with every kind of

unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice *and* mean-spiritedness. They are gossips [spreading rumors],³⁰ slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors [of new forms] of evil, disobedient *and* disrespectful to parents,³¹ without understanding, untrustworthy, unloving, unmerciful [without pity].³² Although they know God's righteous decree *and* His judgment, that those who do such things deserve death, yet they not only do them, but they even [enthusiastically] approve *and* tolerate others who practice them.

10. The Fall of Babylon and the Second Coming of The Lord

Key Spiritual Insights Necessary for This Prophetic Analysis:

- **Babylon, Egypt and Assyria** represent not only a corrupt empires (spiritual, economic, governmental and military), but also systems of idolatry and oppression. Babylon especially symbolizes entrenched **spiritual and economic systems of corruption and rebellion against God**, mirroring human reliance on wealth and power. Babylon's dual role as an ancient nation and a symbol of systemic corruption reaffirms its multifaceted nature as **a satanic economic stronghold**, all of which stand in opposition to God's people.
- **Jerusalem** represents more than a physical city; it is also a spiritual dwelling place for God, both on earth and in heaven, and within His people through the **Holy Spirit**.
- **Nineveh** was the capitol of **Assyria**. It represents the center or head of the snake, the satanic government (Think DC, London, Vatican) —all of which stand in opposition to God's people. After Babylon or Egypt are used to punish God's people for their sins, Assyria becomes His vehicle to “take His divine vengeance” on those who would harm His people. It is a cyclic thing between the three literal and figurative or representative nations or systems.
- **God's Word—Logos** (the written Word) **and Rhema** (the revealed Word through the **Holy Spirit**). While the scriptures provide the literal text, true understanding or revelation, comes through spiritual discernment via the Holy Spirit.
- **Israel**, like “God's Word”, (Logos and Rhema) has two components or there are two types of Israelites. Israelites today are believers in **Christ Jesus indwelt with Holy Spirit**, Jew or Gentile. The **Israelites** referred to in **End Times or Last Days prophecies** are bond servants of **Christ Jesus** acknowledging **His** first coming and eagerly awaiting His return or, His second coming.
- The **wilderness**, as in Ezekiel 20:35 symbolizes the **spiritual testing ground** where God's people are refined.
- **Gog and Magog** reflect a global coalition of rebellious **systems opposing divine authority**, pointing to both physical battles and spiritual conflicts.
- **Jacob's trouble** represents both literal **Israel's trials and the collective spiritual refinement** of God's people.
- The **cosmic upheaval** reflects the **shaking of all created things**, making way for the establishment of God's eternal kingdom.
- **The Mountain of the Lord** in Isaiah 2 symbolizes not only the establishment of **a physical kingdom but also the spiritual elevation of God's authority** over all realms.
- **Mountain** is usually used to represent **a government, authority or kingship**.

- **The Messianic hope**, highlighted in Isaiah, aligns with God's ultimate plan for restoration and eternal reign through **Christ**.
- **Edom represents the enemies of God.**

One has gone forth who plotted evil against the Lord,
A malevolent **[f]counselor [the king of Assyria]**. (Satan via the Pope, Jesuits and Zionists)

12 This is what the Lord says,

**"Though they are at full *strength* and many in number,
Even so, they will be cut off and pass away.
Though I have afflicted you *and* caused you grief [O Jerusalem],
I will afflict you no longer.**

13

**"Now, I will break his yoke [of taxation] off you,
And I will tear off your shackles."**

14

The Lord has given a command concerning you [O king of Nineveh]:
"Your name will no longer be perpetuated.

I will cut off the carved idols and cast images (Hollywood, Main Stream Media, etc.)

From the temple of your gods;

I will prepare your grave,

For you are vile *and* unworthy."

15

Behold, on the mountains the feet of him who brings good news [telling of Assyria's destruction],

Who announces peace *and* prosperity!

Celebrate your feasts, O Judah;

Perform your vows.

**For the wicked one [the king of Assyria] will never again pass through you;
He is completely cut off.**

The Overthrow of Nineveh

2 ^[g]The one who scatters has come up against you [Nineveh].

Man the fortress *and* ramparts, watch the road;

^[h]Strengthen your back [prepare for battle], summon all your strength.

2

For the Lord will restore the splendor *and* majesty of Jacob

Like the splendor of [ancient and united] Israel,

Even though destroyers have destroyed them

And ruined their vine branches.

3

The shields of his soldiers [of ^[i]Media and Babylon] are colored red;

The warriors are dressed in scarlet.

The chariots blaze with fire of [flashing] steel

When he is prepared *to march*,

And the cypress *spears* are brandished [for battle].

4

The chariots race madly in the streets;

They rush wildly in the broad plazas.

Their appearance is like torches;

They rush in various directions like forked lightning.

5

^[j]He remembers *and* summons his nobles;

They stumble in their march [terrified because of the attack].

They hurry to the city wall,

And the ^[k]mantelet is prepared *and* firmly set up.

6

The gates of the rivers [surrounding Nineveh] are opened

And the palace [of sun-dried brick] is dissolved [by the torrents].

7

It is decreed:

Nineveh is stripped, and she is carried away,

And her handmaids are moaning like the sound of doves,

Beating on their breasts [in sorrow].

8

Though Nineveh was like a pool of water throughout her days,

Now her inhabitants are fleeing;

“Stop! Stop!” [a few cry.]

But no one turns back.

9

Plunder the silver!

Plunder the gold!

For there is no end to the treasure—

Wealth from every precious object.

10

She is emptied! She is desolate and waste!

**Hearts melting [in fear] and knees knocking!
Anguish is in the whole body,
And the faces of all grow pale!** (Panic in DC)

¹¹

Where is the den of the lions (Assyria)
And the feeding place of the young lions,
Where the lion, lioness, and lion's cub prowled
With nothing to fear?

¹²

The lion [of Assyria] tore enough for his cubs (Assyrian citizens),
Killed [enough prey] for his lionesses,
And filled his lairs with prey
And his dens with torn flesh.

¹³ “Behold, I am against you [Nineveh],” declares the Lord of hosts, “and I will burn your chariots in the smoke, and the sword will devour your young lions. I will cut off your prey from the land, and the voice of your messengers will no longer be heard.”

Nineveh's Complete Ruin

**3 Woe (judgment is coming) to the city of blood [guilty of murder and mayhem],
completely full of lies and pillage;
Her prey never departs [alive].**

The noise of the [cracking of the] whip,
The noise of the rattling of the wheel,
Galloping horses
And rumbling *and* bounding chariots [in the assault of Nineveh]!

³

Horsemen charging,
Swords flashing, spears gleaming,
Many slain, a mass of corpses,
No end of corpses—
The horsemen stumble over the corpses!

All because of the many acts of prostitution of [Nineveh] the prostitute,
The charming *and* well-favored one, the mistress of sorceries,
Who betrays nations by her acts of prostitution (idolatry)
And families by her sorceries.

“Behold, I am against you,” declares the Lord of hosts,
“And I will lift up your skirts over your face,
And I will let the nations look at your nakedness [O Nineveh]

7

“And it will come about that all who see you
Will shrink back *and* run from you and say,
‘Nineveh is completely ruined!

Are you better than ¹¹Thebes,
Which was situated by the waters of the Nile,
With water surrounding her,
Whose defense was the sea (the Nile),
Whose wall *consisted* of the sea?

9

Ethiopia was her strength,
And Egypt too, without limits.
[m]Put and Lubim were among her helpers.

10

Yet she became an exile;
She went into captivity.
Her young children were dashed to pieces
At the head of every street;
They cast lots for her honorable men,
And all her great men were bound with chains.

11

You too [Nineveh] will become drunk [with the cup of God’s wrath];
You will be hidden.
You too [Nineveh] will search [in vain] for a refuge from the enemy.

12

All your fortresses are [nothing but] fig trees with ripe figs—
When shaken they fall into the mouth of the eater.

13

Behold, your people are [as weak and helpless as] women in your midst!
The gates of your land are opened wide to your enemies;
Fire consumes the bars across your gates.

14

Draw water for a [long, continued] siege!
Strengthen your fortresses!
Go down to the clay pits, trample the mortar!
Prepare the brick kiln [to burn bricks for the rampart]!

15

But there [in the very midst of these preparations] the fire will devour you;
The sword will cut you down;
It will devour you as the locust does.

Multiply yourself like the creeping locusts;
Multiply yourself like the swarming locusts.

16

You have increased your traders more than the [visible] stars of heaven—
The creeping locust strips *and* destroys and then flies away.

17

Your guardsmen are like the swarming locusts.
Your marshals are like the hordes of grasshoppers
Settling in the stone walls on a cold day.
When the sun rises, they fly away,
And no one knows the place where they are.

18

Your shepherds are asleep, O king of Assyria;
Your nobles are lying down [in death].

Message to the Seven Churches

4 [c]John, to the seven churches that are in [the province of] [d]Asia: [e]Grace [be granted] to you and peace [inner calm and spiritual well-being], from Him Who is [existing forever] and Who was [continually existing in the past] and Who is to come, and from [f]the seven Spirits that are before His throne, **5** and from Jesus Christ, the [g]faithful *and* trustworthy Witness, the [h]Firstborn of the dead, and the Ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who [always] loves us and who [has once for all] [i]freed us [or washed us] from our sins by His own blood (His sacrificial death)— **6** and formed us into a kingdom [as His subjects], [i]priests to His God and Father—to Him be the glory *and* the power *and* the majesty and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. **7** Behold, **He is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him; and all the tribes (nations) of the earth will mourn over Him [realizing their sin and guilt, and anticipating the coming wrath].** [k]So it is to be. Amen.

The Coming of Christ the Conqueror

7

8

**“Because you [king of Babylon] have looted many nations,
All peoples who are left will loot you—**
Because of human bloodshed and for the violence done to the land,
To the city and all its inhabitants.

9

**“Woe (judgment is coming) to him who obtains wicked gain for his house [and thinks by so
doing]
To set his nest on high,
That he may be rescued from the hand of evil.**

10

**“You have devised a shameful thing for your house
By cutting off *and* putting an end to many peoples;
So you are sinning against your own life *and* forfeiting it.**

11

“For the stone will cry out from the wall [to accuse you—built in sin!]
And the rafter will answer it out of the woodwork.

12

“Woe (judgment is coming) to him who builds a city with bloodshed
And establishes a town by violence!

13

“Is it not indeed from the Lord of hosts
That peoples labor [only] for the fire [that will destroy their work],
And nations grow weary for nothing [that is, things which have no lasting value]?

14

**“But [the time is coming when] the earth shall be filled
With the knowledge of the glory of the Lord,
As the waters cover the sea.**

15

**“Woe (judgment is coming) to you who make your neighbors drink,
Who mix in your venom to make them drunk
So that you may look at their nakedness!** (Epstein Island & P Diddy)

16

**“You will be filled with disgrace instead of honor.
Now drink and expose your own nakedness!
The cup [of wrath] in the Lord’s right hand will come around to you [O destroyer],
And utter disgrace will be on your own glory.**

17

“For the violence done to Lebanon will overwhelm you;
The destruction of the animals will terrify you
On account of human bloodshed and the violence done to the land,
To the city and all its inhabitants.

18

**“What profit is the carved image when its maker has formed it?
It is only a cast image, and a teacher of lies. (Hollywood & MSM)
For its maker trusts in his own creation [as his god]
When he makes speechless idols.**

19

“Woe (judgment is coming) to him who says to the wooden image, ‘Awake!’
And to the speechless stone, ‘Arise!’
And that is your teacher?
Look, it is overlaid with gold and silver,
And there is no breath at all inside it.

20

“But the Lord is in His holy temple.
Let all the earth hush *and* be silent before Him.”

11. The Stone Era (what our Forefathers understood and what this is all about)

The King's Forgotten Dream

2 In the second year (604 B.C.) of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams which troubled *and* disturbed his spirit and [interfered with] his ability to sleep. **2** Then the king gave a command to call the magicians, the enchanters, the sorcerers, and the ^[a] Chaldeans to tell the king his dreams. So they came in and stood before the king. **3** The king said to them, “I had a dream, and my spirit is troubled *and* anxious to know the [content and meaning of the] dream.”

The Secret Is Revealed to Daniel

19 Then the secret was revealed to Daniel in a vision of the night, and Daniel blessed the God of heaven. **20** Daniel answered,

“Blessed be the name of God forever and ever,
For wisdom and power belong to Him.

21

“It is He who changes the times and the seasons;
He removes kings and establishes kings.
He gives wisdom to the wise
and [greater] knowledge to those who have understanding!

22

“It is He who reveals the profound and hidden things;
He knows what is in the darkness,
And the light dwells with Him.

23

“I thank You and praise You, O God of my fathers,
For You have given me wisdom and power;
Even now You have made known to me what we requested of You,
For You have made known to us [the solution to] the king's matter.”

24 So Daniel went to Arioch, whom the king had appointed to destroy the wise men of Babylon; he went and said this to him: “Do not execute the wise men of Babylon! Bring me before the king, and I will reveal to the king the interpretation [of his dream].”

25 Then Arioch hurriedly brought Daniel before the king and said this to him: “I have found a man among the exiles of Judah who can explain to the king the interpretation [of the dream].” **26** The king said to Daniel, whose [Babylonian] name was Belteshazzar, “Are you able to reveal to me the [content of the] dream which I have seen and its interpretation?” **27** Daniel answered the king and said, “Regarding the mystery about which the king has inquired, neither the wise men, enchanters, magicians, nor astrologers are able to answer the king, **28** but there is a God in heaven who reveals secrets, and He has shown King Nebuchadnezzar what will take place in the latter days (end of days). This was your dream and the vision [that appeared] in your mind while on your bed. **29** As for you, O king, as you were lying on your bed thoughts came into your mind about what will take place in the future; and He who reveals secrets has shown you what will occur. **30** But as for me, this secret has not been revealed to me because my wisdom is

greater than that of any other living man, but in order to make the interpretation known to the king, and so that you may understand [fully] the thoughts of your mind.

The King's Dream

31 "You, O king, were looking, and behold, [there was] a single great statue; this image, which was large and of unsurpassed splendor, stood before you, and its appearance was awesome *and* terrifying. **32** As for this ^dstatue, its head *was made* of fine gold, its breast and its arms of silver, its belly and its thighs of bronze, **33** its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay [pottery]. **34** As you were looking, a ^estone was cut out without [human] hands, and it struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and crushed them. **35** Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together and became like the chaff from the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away so that not a trace of them could be found. And the stone that struck the statue became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.

The Interpretation—Babylon the First Kingdom

36 "This was the dream; now we will tell the king its interpretation. **37** You, O king, are the king of [earthly] kings, to whom the God of heaven has given the kingdom, the power, the strength and the glory; **38** and wherever the sons of men dwell, and the beasts of the field, and the birds of the heavens, He has given them into your hand and has made you ruler over them all. You [king of Babylon] are the head of gold.

Medo-Persia and Greece

39 After you will arise another kingdom (Medo-Persia) inferior to you, and then a third kingdom of bronze (Greece under Alexander the Great), which will rule over all the earth.

Rome (Vatican & Satanism)

40 Then a fourth kingdom (Rome) will be strong as iron, for iron breaks to pieces and shatters all things; and like iron which crushes things in pieces, it will break and crush all these [others]. **41** And as you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, it will be a divided (Catholicism & Protestantism or Satanism & Christianity?) kingdom; but there will be in it some of the durability *and* strength of iron, just as you saw the iron mixed with common clay. **42** As the [ten] toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of clay, so some of the kingdom will be strong, and *another* part of it will be brittle. **43** And as you saw the iron mixed with common clay, so they will combine with one another in the seed of men; but they will not merge [for such diverse things or ideologies cannot unite], even as iron does not mix with clay.

The Divine Kingdom (Authority)

44 **In the days of those [final ten] kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom** that will never be destroyed, nor will its sovereignty be left for another people; but **it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it will stand forever.** **45** Just as **you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands** and that it crushed the iron, the bronze, the clay, the

silver and the gold, the great God has revealed to the king what will take place in the future; so the dream is true and its interpretation is trustworthy."

Isaiah 9:6-7 Amplified Bible

6

For to us a Child shall be born, to us **a Son shall be given;**
And the government shall be upon His shoulder,
And His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

7

There shall be no end to the increase of His government and of peace,
[He shall rule] on the throne of David and over his kingdom,

“I said, ‘Most certainly you will [reverently] fear Me;
Accept correction.’
So Jerusalem’s dwelling will not be cut off
In accordance with all that I have appointed concerning her [punishment],
But they were eager [even rising early] to make all their deeds corrupt.

**“Therefore [you of the godly remnant of Judah, patiently] wait for Me,” declares the Lord,

On whom the reproach [of exile] is a burden.

19

“Behold, at that time I am going to deal
With all your oppressors;
I will save the lame
And gather the scattered,
And I will turn their shame into praise and renown
In every land [where they have suffered].

20

“At that time I will bring you in,
Yes, at the time I gather you together;
For I will make you a name and a praise
Among all the peoples of the earth
When I restore your fortunes [and freedom] before your eyes,”
Says the Lord.

13. Final Reflections

The "city upon a hill" metaphor has been invoked by modern leaders to emphasize America's role as a moral example. President Ronald Reagan, in his farewell address on January 11, 1989, stated:

"I've spoken of the shining city all my political life... In my mind, it was a tall, proud city built on rocks stronger than oceans, windswept, God-blessed, and teeming with people of all kinds living in harmony and peace."

Reagan's reference underscores the enduring vision of America as a beacon of hope and moral clarity.

Similarly, Trump says in inaugural remarks "**“doesn’t it seem brighter to you?”**

Isaiah 60 Amplified Bible

These writings and speeches illustrate the Founding Fathers' and subsequent leaders' belief in America's covenant with God and its intended role as a "city upon a hill," serving as an example to all nations.

Haggai 1-2 Amplified Bible

Haggai Begins Temple Building (Covenanted Republic Restoration, Trump the new Zerubbabel?)

1 In the second year of ^[a]Darius the king [of Persia], on the first day of the sixth month (Aug 29, 520 b.c.), the word of the Lord came by **Haggai the prophet to Zerubbabel** the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, saying, ²“Thus says the Lord of hosts: ‘These people say, “The time has not come that the Lord’s house (temple) should be ^[b]rebuilt.”’” ³Then the word of the Lord came by Haggai the prophet, saying, ⁴“Is it time for you yourselves to live in your [expensive] paneled houses while this house [of the Lord] lies in ruins?” ⁵Now therefore, thus says the Lord of hosts, “Consider your ways *and* thoughtfully reflect on your conduct! ⁶You have planted much, but you harvest little; you eat, but you do not have *enough*; you drink, but you do not have *enough* to be intoxicated; you clothe yourselves, but no one is warm *enough*; and he who earns wages earns them *just to put* them in a bag with holes in it [because God has withheld His blessing].”

⁷ Thus says the Lord of hosts, “Consider your ways *and* thoughtfully reflect on your conduct! ⁸Go up to the hill country, bring lumber and rebuild My house (temple), that I may be pleased with it and be glorified,” says the Lord [accepting it as done for My glory]. ⁹You look for much [harvest], but it comes to little; and even when you bring that home, I blow it *away*. Why?” says the Lord of hosts. **“Because of My house, which lies in ruins while each of you runs to his own house [eager to enjoy it].** ¹⁰Therefore, because of you [that is, your sin and disobedience] **the heavens withhold the dew and the earth withholds its produce.** ¹¹I called for a drought on the land and the hill country, on the grain, on the new wine, on the oil, on what the ground produces, on men, on cattle, and on all the labor of your hands.”

¹² Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel and Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people [who had returned from exile], listened carefully *and* obeyed the voice of the Lord their God and the words of Haggai the prophet, since the Lord their God had sent

him. And the people [reverently] feared the Lord. ¹³ Then Haggai, the Lord's messenger, spoke the Lord's message to the people saying, “‘I am with you,’ declares the Lord.” ¹⁴ So the Lord stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and worked on the house of the Lord of hosts, their God, ¹⁵ on the ^[c]twenty-fourth day of the sixth month (Sept 21, 520 b.c.) in the second year of Darius the king.

The Builders Encouraged

2 On the twenty-first day of the ^[d]seventh month (Oct 17, 520 b.c., the second year of Darius king of Persia), the word of the Lord came by the prophet Haggai, saying, ² “Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and to the remnant of the people, saying, ³ ‘Who is left among you who saw this ^[e]house (temple) in its former glory? And how do you see it now? Does it not seem to you like nothing in comparison? ⁴ But now be courageous, Zerubbabel,’ declares the Lord, ‘be courageous also, Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and be courageous, all you people of the land,’ declares the Lord, ‘and work; for I am with you,’ declares the Lord of hosts. ⁵ ‘As for the promise which I made with you when you came out of Egypt, My Spirit stands [firm and immovable] *and continues with you; do not fear!*’ ⁶ For thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘Once more, in a little while, I am going to shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. ⁷ I will shake all the nations; and they will come with the desirable *and* precious things of all nations, and I will fill this house with glory *and* splendor,’ says the Lord of hosts. ⁸ ‘The silver is Mine and the gold is Mine,’ declares the Lord of hosts. ⁹ ‘The latter ^[f]glory of this house will be greater than the former,’ says the Lord of hosts, ‘and in this place I shall give [the ultimate] peace *and* prosperity,’ declares the Lord of hosts.”

¹⁰ On the twenty-fourth day of the ninth month (Dec 18, 520 b.c.), in the second year of Darius, the word of the Lord came to Haggai the prophet, saying, ¹¹ “Thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘Ask the priests for a ruling: ¹² If a man carries meat that is holy [because it has been offered in sacrifice to God] in the fold of his garment, and he touches bread, or cooked food, or wine, or oil, or any [kind of] food with this fold, does what he touches become holy [dedicated exclusively to God's service]?’” And the priests answered, “No!” ^[g] Holiness is not transferrable.] ¹³ Then Haggai said, “If one who is [ceremonially] unclean because of [contact with] a corpse touches any of these [articles of food], will it be unclean?” And the priests answered, “It will be unclean.” [Ceremonial uncleanness, like sin, is infectious.] ¹⁴ Then Haggai answered, “‘So is this people. And so is this nation before Me,’ declares the Lord, ‘and so is every work of their hands; and what they offer there [on the altar] is unclean [because they who offer it are unclean]. ¹⁵ But now, do consider [what will happen] from this day forward: before one stone was placed on another in the temple of the Lord, ¹⁶ from that time when one came to a *grain* heap *expecting* twenty *measures*, there would be only ten; and when one came to the wine vat to draw out fifty measures, there would be only twenty. ¹⁷ I struck you and the work of your hands with scorching wind, mildew, and hail; yet you did not come back to Me,’ declares the Lord. ¹⁸ ‘Do consider from this day forward, from the twenty-fourth day of the ninth month; from the day when the temple of the Lord was founded, consider: ¹⁹ Is the seed still in the barn?

As to the vine, the fig tree, the pomegranate, and the olive tree—they have not produced. Yet from this day on I will bless you [in the harvest of your crops].””

The Covenanted Republic Restored

20 And again the word of the Lord came to Haggai on the twenty-fourth day of the month (Dec 18, 520 b.c.), saying, **21** “**Speak to [h]Zerubbabel governor of Judah, saying, ‘I am going to shake the heavens and the earth. 22 I will [in the distant future] overthrow the thrones of kingdoms and destroy the power of the kingdoms of the [ungodly] nations; and I will overthrow the chariots and those who ride in them, and the horses and their riders will go down, every one by the sword of his brother [annihilating one another]. 23 On that day,’** declares the Lord of hosts, ‘I will take you, **Zerubbabel**, the son of Shealtiel, My servant,’ declares the Lord, ‘**and I will make you [through the Messiah, your descendant] like a [l]signet ring, for I have chosen you [as the one with whom to renew My covenant to David’s line],”** declares the Lord of hosts.

Zechariah 1-5 Amplified Bible

A Call to Repentance

1 In **[a]**the eighth month of the second year [of the reign] of **[b]Darius** [the king of Persia], the word of the Lord came to Zechariah (the Lord remembers) the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo, the prophet, saying, **2 “The Lord was extremely angry with your fathers. 3 Therefore say to the Jews, ‘Thus says the Lord of hosts (armies), ‘Return to Me,’ declares the Lord of hosts, ‘and I shall return to you. 4 Do not be like your fathers, to whom the former prophets proclaimed, ‘Thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘Repent [that is, change your way of thinking] and return now from your evil way [of life] and from your evil deeds.’”** But they did not listen or pay attention to Me,” declares the Lord. **5 “Your fathers, where are they? And the prophets, do they live forever? 6 But did not My words (warnings) and My statutes, which I commanded My servants the prophets, overtake your fathers? Then they repented and said, ‘As the Lord of hosts planned to do to us [in discipline and punishment], in accordance with our ways and our deeds, so has He dealt with us.”””**

15 But I am very angry with the [l]nations who are at ease and feel secure; for while I was only a little angry, they [l]furthered the disaster [against the people of Israel].” 16 Therefore, thus says the Lord, “I have returned to Jerusalem with mercy and compassion. My house shall be built in it,” says the Lord of hosts, “and a [l]measuring line shall be stretched out over Jerusalem.”” 17 Proclaim again, ‘Thus says the Lord of hosts, “My cities shall again overflow with prosperity, and the Lord shall again comfort Zion and again choose Jerusalem.”””

God’s Favor to Zion (No walls in the “New Jerusalem, because he is in us and we will be changed)

2 And I looked up, and saw a man with a measuring line in his hand. **2** So I said, “Where are you going?” And he said to me, “To measure Jerusalem, to see how wide it is and how long it is.” **3** And behold, the angel who was speaking with me was going out, and another angel was coming out to meet him, **4** and he said to the second angel, “Run, speak to that young man, saying, ‘**Jerusalem will be inhabited [like villages] without walls [spreading out into the open country] because of the great number of people and livestock in it.** **5** For I,’ declares the Lord, ‘will be a wall of fire around her [protecting her from enemies], and I will be the glory in her midst.’”

(The Lord is coming and we’re leaving Babylon)

6 “**I**Hear this! Flee from [Babylon] the land of the north [which shall come under judgment],” declares the Lord, “for I have scattered you like the four winds of the heavens,” declares the Lord. **7** “**Hear, Zion (Jerusalem)! Escape, you who are living with the daughter of Babylon!**” **8** For thus says the Lord of hosts, “**After glory He has sent Me against the nations which plunder you—for he who touches you, touches the apple of His eye.** **9** Behold, I will wave my hand over them and they shall become plunder for their own slaves. Then you shall know (recognize, understand fully) that the Lord of hosts has sent Me. **10** Sing for joy and rejoice, O Daughter of Zion; for behold, I am coming, and I will dwell in your midst,” declares the Lord. **11** Many nations shall join themselves to the Lord in that day and shall be My people. And I will dwell in your midst, and you shall know (recognize, understand fully) that the Lord of hosts has sent Me to you. **12** The Lord will take possession of Judah as His portion in the holy land and will again choose Jerusalem.

13 “**Be still before the Lord, all mankind; for He is roused (raised up) from His holy habitation [in response to His persecuted people].**”

Joshua, the High Priest (Forgiveness, unity and restoration)

3 Then the guiding angel showed me Joshua the high priest [representing disobedient, sinful Israel] standing before the **Angel of the Lord**, and Satan standing at Joshua’s right hand to be his adversary *and* to accuse him. **2** And the Lord said to Satan, “**The Lord rebuke you, Satan! Even the Lord, who [now and ever] has chosen Jerusalem, rebuke you! Is this not a [m]log snatched and rescued from the fire?**” **3** Now Joshua was clothed with **filthy** (nauseatingly vile) garments and was standing before the Angel [of the Lord]. **4** He spoke to those who stood before Him, saying, “Remove the filthy garments from him.” And He said to Joshua, “See, I have caused your wickedness to be taken away from you, and I will clothe *and* beautify you with rich robes [of forgiveness].” **5** And I (Zechariah) said, “Let them put a clean turban on his head.” So they put a clean turban on his head and clothed him with [rich] garments. And the Angel of the Lord stood by.

6 **And the Angel of the Lord [solemnly and earnestly] admonished Joshua, saying, 7 “Thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘If you will walk in My ways [that is, remain faithful] and perform My service, then you will also govern My house and have charge of My courts, and I will give you free access [to My presence] among these who are standing here.**

The Branch

8 Now listen, Joshua, the high priest, you and your colleagues who are sitting in front of you—indeed they are men who are a symbol [of what is to come]—for behold, I am going to bring in My servant the **Branch** [in Messianic glory]. **9** For behold, the **stone** which I have set before Joshua; on that one

stone are seven eyes (symbolizing infinite intelligence, omniscience). Behold, I will engrave an inscription on it,' declares the Lord of hosts, 'and I will remove the wickedness *and* guilt of this land in a single day. ¹⁰ In that day,' declares the Lord of hosts, 'every one of you will invite his neighbor to sit under his vine and his fig tree [enjoying peace and prosperity in the kingdom].'"

The Golden Lampstand and Olive Trees

4 And the angel who was speaking with me came back and awakened me, like a man who is awakened out of his sleep. ² He said to me, "What do you see?" I said, "I see, and behold, a ¹lampstand all of gold, with its bowl [for oil] on the top of it and its seven lamps on it with seven spouts belonging to each of the lamps which are on the top of it. ³ And there are two olive trees by it, one on the right side of the bowl and the other on its left side [supplying it continuously with oil]." ⁴ So I asked the angel who was speaking with me, "What are these, my lord?" ⁵ Then the angel who was speaking with me answered me, "Do you not know what these are?" And I said, "No, my lord."

(Not by might but, by the Spirit!)

⁶ Then he said to me, "This [continuous supply of oil] is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel [prince of Judah], saying, '**Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit [of whom the oil is a symbol],**' says the Lord of hosts. ⁷ 'What are you, O great mountain [of obstacles]? Before Zerubbabel [who will rebuild the temple] you *will become* a plain (insignificant)! And he will bring out the capstone [of the new temple] with loud shouts of "Grace, grace to it!"'"

(Trump the new Zerubbabel? God leveling the ground for him to build the new temple)

⁸ Also the word of the Lord came to me, saying, ⁹ "**The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundations of this house, and his hands will finish it.** Then you will know (recognize, understand fully) that the Lord of hosts has sent me [as His messenger] to you. ¹⁰ Who [with reason] despises the day of small things (beginnings)? **For these ¹seven [eyes] shall rejoice when they see the plumb line in the hand of Zerubbabel. They are the eyes of the Lord which roam throughout the earth.**"

¹¹ Then I said to him [who was speaking with me], "What are these two olive trees on the right side of the lampstand and on its left?" ¹² And a second time I said to him, "**What are these two olive branches which are beside the two golden pipes by which the golden oil is emptied?**" ¹³ And he answered me, "Do you not know what these are?" And I said, "No, my lord." ¹⁴ Then he said, "**These are the two ¹sons of fresh oil [Joshua the high priest and Zerubbabel the prince of Judah] who are standing by the Lord of the whole earth [as His anointed ones].**" (Musk & Trump?)

The Flying Scroll (The curse for the thieves the USAID, IRS, Federal Reserve, etc. audits identify.)

5 Again I looked up, and I saw a scroll flying *in the air!* ² And the angel said to me, "What do you see?" And I answered, "I see a ¹flying scroll; its length is twenty cubits (thirty feet) and its width is ten cubits (fifteen feet)." ³ Then he said to me, "**This is the curse that is going out over the face of the whole land; for everyone who steals will be cut off according to the writing on one side, and everyone who swears [oaths falsely] shall be cut off according to the writing on the other side.** ⁴ I will send the curse out," declares the Lord of hosts, "and it will enter the house of the thief and the house of the one who swears falsely by My name; and it will spend the night in that house and consume it, both its timber and its stones."

⁵Then the angel who was speaking with me came forward and said to me, "Now look up and see what this is going forth." ⁶And I said, "What is it?" And he said, "This is the ^uephah (grain basket) going forth. This," he continued, "is their appearance throughout the land ⁷(and behold, a [round, flat] lead ^vcover was lifted up); and there sat a woman inside the ephah." ⁸Then he said, "This is Wickedness (Godlessness)!" And he threw her back down into the middle of the ephah and threw the lead cover on its opening. ⁹Then I looked up, and there were two women coming out with the wind in their wings; and they had wings like the wings of a stork, and they lifted up the ephah between the earth and the heavens. ¹⁰I said to the angel who was speaking with me, "Where are they taking the ephah?" ¹¹And he said to me, "To the land of Shinar (Babylon) to build a temple for her; and when it is prepared, ^wshe shall be set there on her own pedestal."

Zechariah 8-14 Amplified Bible

The Coming Peace and Prosperity of Zion, Return to Jerusalem

8 Then the word of the Lord of hosts came [to me], saying, ²"Thus says the Lord of hosts, 'I am ^ajealous for Zion with great jealousy [demanding what is rightfully and uniquely mine], and I am jealous for her with great wrath [against her enemies].'" ³Thus says the Lord, '**I shall return to Zion and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem, and Jerusalem shall be called the [faithful] City of Truth, and the mountain of the Lord of hosts will be called the Holy Mountain.**' ⁴Thus says the Lord of hosts, 'Old men and old women will again sit in the ^bstreets (public places) of Jerusalem, each man with his staff in his hand because of his advanced age. ⁵And the streets of the city will be filled with boys and girls playing in its streets.' ⁶Thus says the Lord of hosts, 'If it is difficult in the eyes of the remnant of this people in those days [in which this comes to pass], will it also be difficult in My sight?' declares the Lord of hosts. ⁷Thus says the Lord of hosts, '**Behold, I am going to save My people from the east country and from the west, ⁸and I will bring them home and they will live in the midst of Jerusalem; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God in truth (faithfulness) and in righteousness.**'

⁹"Thus says the Lord of hosts, '**Let your hands be strong, you who in these days hear these words from the mouths of the prophets who, on the day that the foundation of the house of the Lord of hosts was laid, foretold that the temple might be rebuilt.**' ¹⁰For before those days there were no wages for man or animal; nor was there any peace *or* success for him who went out or came in because of his enemies, for I set all men against one another. ¹¹But now [in this time since you began to build] I will not treat the remnant of this people as in the former days,' declares the Lord of hosts. ¹²'For there the seed will produce peace *and* prosperity; the vine will yield its fruit, and the ground will produce its increase, and the heavens will give their dew. And I will cause the remnant of this people to inherit *and* possess all these things. ¹³And as you have been a curse among the nations, O house of Judah (Southern Kingdom) and house of Israel (Northern Kingdom), so I will save you, that you may be a blessing. Fear not; let your hands be strong.'

¹⁴"For thus says the Lord of hosts, 'Just as I planned to do harm to you when your fathers provoked Me to wrath,' says the Lord of hosts, 'and I did not relent, ¹⁵**so I have again planned in these days to do good to Jerusalem and to the house of Judah. Do not fear!** ¹⁶**These are the things which you should do: speak the truth with one another; judge with truth and pronounce the judgment that brings peace in [the courts at] your gates.**' ¹⁷And let none of you devise *or* even imagine evil in your heart against another, and do not love lying *or* half-truths; for all these things I hate,' declares the Lord."

¹⁸Then the word of the Lord of hosts came to me (Zechariah), saying, ¹⁹“Thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘The fast of the fourth [month to mourn the breaching of Jerusalem’s walls], the fast of the fifth [month to mourn the temple’s destruction], the fast of the seventh [month to mourn Gedaliah’s assassination], and the fast of the tenth [month to mourn the siege of Jerusalem] will become times of joy and gladness and cheerful feasts for the house of Judah; so [to bring this about] love truth and peace.’”

²⁰“Thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘It will come to pass that peoples and the inhabitants of many cities will come [to Jerusalem]. ²¹The inhabitants of one [city] will go to another, saying, “Let us go at once to ask the favor of the Lord and to seek the Lord of hosts. I will go also.” ²²So many peoples and powerful nations will come to seek the Lord of hosts in Jerusalem and to ask the Lord for His favor.’ ²³Thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘In those days ten men [as representatives] from all the nations will grasp the robe of a Jew, saying, “Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you.”’”

Prophecies against Neighboring Nations (Stinks to be a bad guy, Trumpets and Storms)

9 The ^[c]oracle (a burdensome message) of the word of the Lord is against the land of Hadrach [in Syria], with Damascus as its resting place (for the eyes of men, especially of all the tribes of Israel, are toward the Lord),

And Hamath also, which borders on it (Damascus),
Tyre and Sidon, though they are very wise.

For Tyre built herself an [impregnable] stronghold [on an island offshore],
And she has heaped up silver like dust
And gold like the mire of the streets.

 And His dominion shall be from sea to sea [absolutely endless],
 And from the River [Euphrates] to the ends of the earth.

Salvation of Judah and Ephraim

As for you also, because of the blood of My covenant with you [My chosen people, the covenant that was sealed with blood]
 I have freed your prisoners from the waterless pit.

Return to the stronghold [of security and prosperity], O prisoners who have the hope;
 Even today I am declaring that I will restore double [your former prosperity] to you [as firstborn among nations].

For I will bend Judah as My bow,
 I will fit the bow with Ephraim [as My arrow].
 And I will stir up your sons, O Zion, against your sons, O Greece,
 And will make you [Israel] like the sword of a warrior.

Then the Lord will be seen [hovering] over them [protecting His people],

For how great is God's goodness and how great is His beauty! And how great [He will make Israel's] goodness and [Israel's] beauty!

Grain and new wine will make the young men and virgins flourish.

God Will Bless Judah and Ephraim (But pastors and fake prophets (MSM, Hollywood, etc.) are in trouble)

**10 Ask for rain from the Lord at the time of the spring rain.
It is the Lord who makes the thunder clouds;
And He will give them showers of rain, grass in the field to everyone.**

2

For the teraphim (household idols) speak wickedness (emptiness, worthlessness),
And the **diviners see lying visions**
And tell false dreams;
They comfort in vain.
Therefore the people wander like sheep,
They are afflicted *and* suffer because there is no shepherd.

3

**"My anger is kindled against the shepherds [who are not true shepherds],
And I shall punish the male goats (leaders);
For the Lord of hosts has visited His flock, the house of Judah (the Southern Kingdom),
And will make them like His beautiful *and* majestic horse in the battle.**

**"From them (Judah) shall come the ¹Cornerstone,
From them the tent peg,
From them the bow of battle,
From them every ruler, all of them together.**

5

**"They will be like mighty men
Trampling down *their* enemies in the mire of the streets in the battle;
And they will fight because the Lord is with them,
And the [enemies'] riders on horses will be shamed.**

6

**"I will strengthen the house of Judah [making it superior],
And I will save the house of Joseph.
I will bring them back [and allow them to live securely],
Because I have had compassion on them.
They will be as though I had not rejected them,**

For I am the Lord their God, and I will listen *and* answer them.

7

“Then **Ephraim will be like a mighty warrior,**
And their heart will rejoice as if from wine;
Yes, their children will see it and rejoice;
Their heart will rejoice *and* shout triumphantly in the Lord.

8

“I will **whistle** for them and gather them together,
For I have redeemed them;
And they will increase [again] as they have increased before [in Egypt].

9

“When I scatter them among the nations,
They will remember Me in far countries,
And **with their children they will live and come back [to Me and the land I gave them].**

10

I will bring them (all Israel) back home again from the land of Egypt
And gather them from Assyria,
And I will bring them into the land of Gilead and Lebanon [the land on the east and on the west of the Jordan]
Until no room can be found for them.

11

“And they will pass through the sea of distress *and* anxiety [with the Lord leading His people, as at the Red Sea]
And He will strike the waves in the sea,
So that all the depths of **the Nile will dry up;**
And the pride of Assyria will be brought down
And the scepter [of the taskmasters] of Egypt will pass away.

“And I will strengthen Israel in the Lord,
And **they will walk [and glory] in His name,**” declares the Lord.

The Doomed Flock (This has not been fully opened to me yet. Could be the government, church and prophets (MSM))

11 Open your doors, O Lebanon,
That fire may devour your cedars.

2

Wail, O cypress, for the cedar has fallen,
Because the magnificent trees have been destroyed;
Wail, O oaks of Bashan,
For the inaccessible forest [on the steep mountainside] has come down.

3

There is a sound of the shepherds’ wail,
For their splendor (grazing land) is ruined;

There is a sound of the young lions' roar,
For the pride of the Jordan is ruined.

⁴Thus says the Lord my God, “**Pasture the flock doomed for slaughter, ⁵whose buyers slay them and go unpunished, and those who sell them say, ‘Blessed be the Lord, for I have become rich!’ And their own shepherds have no pity on them nor protect them [from the wolves].** ⁶For I will no longer have pity on the inhabitants of the land,” declares the Lord; “but behold, I will cause the men to fall, each into the hand of another and into the hands of his [foreign] king. And the enemy will strike the land, and I will not rescue the people from their hand.”

⁷So I [Zechariah] pastured the flock *doomed for slaughter*, truly [as the name implies] the most miserable of sheep. And I took two [shepherd's] staffs, the one I called Favor (Grace) and the other I called Union (Bonds); so I pastured the flock. ⁸Then I eliminated the three [incompetent, unfit] shepherds [the civil rulers, the priests, and the prophets] in one month, for I was impatient with them, and they also were tired of me *and despised me.* ⁹So I said, “I will not pasture you. What is to die, let it die, and what is to be destroyed, let it be destroyed; and let the survivors devour one another's flesh.” ¹⁰I took my staff, Favor, and broke it in pieces, breaking the covenant which I had made with all the peoples. ¹¹So the covenant was broken on that day, and thus the most wretched of the flock who were watching me realized that it was the word of the Lord. ¹²I said to them, “If it seems good to you, give me my wages; but if not, do not.” So they weighed out ¹³thirty pieces of silver as my wages. ¹³^[m]Then the Lord said to me, “Throw it to the potter [as if to the dogs]—that *magnificent* sum at which I am valued by them!” So I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw them to the potter in the house of the Lord. ¹⁴Then I broke my second staff, Union, into pieces to break the brotherhood between Judah (the Southern Kingdom) and Israel (the Northern Kingdom).

¹⁵The Lord said to me, “Take again for yourself the equipment [of a shepherd, but this time] of a foolish shepherd. ¹⁶For behold, I am going to raise up a [false] shepherd in the land who will not care for the perishing, seek the scattered, heal the broken, or feed the healthy; but will eat the flesh of the fat ones and tear off their hoofs [to consume everything].

**“Woe (judgment is coming) to the worthless *and* foolish shepherd
Who deserts the flock!**

The sword will strike his arm
And his right eye!
His arm shall be totally withered
And his right eye completely blinded.”

Jerusalem to Be Attacked, Her Enemies to be Destroyed

12 The ^[n]oracle (a burdensome message) of the word of the Lord concerning Israel.

Thus declares the Lord who stretches out the heavens and lays the foundation of the earth and forms the spirit of man within him: ²“**Behold, I am going to make Jerusalem a cup that causes reeling (staggering) to all the surrounding peoples; and when the siege is against Jerusalem, it will also be against Judah.** ³And in that day I will make Jerusalem a heavy stone for all the peoples; all who lift it will be severely injured. And all the nations of the earth will come *and* be gathered against it. ⁴In that

day,” declares the Lord, “I will strike every horse with panic and his rider with madness; but I will open My eyes *and* watch over the house of Judah, and will strike every horse of the [opposing] nations with blindness.⁵ Then the clans of Judah will say in their hearts, ‘The inhabitants of Jerusalem are our strength in the Lord of hosts, their God.’

6 “In that day I will make the clans of Judah like a firepot in a woodpile, and like a flaming torch among sheaves [of grain]. They will devour all the surrounding peoples on the right hand and on the left; and the people of Jerusalem will again live [securely] in their own place, in Jerusalem. **7** The Lord shall save the tents of Judah first, so that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem will not be magnified above Judah. **8** In that day the Lord will defend the people of Jerusalem, and the one who is impaired among them in that day [of persecution] will become [strong and noble] like David; and the house of David ⁹will be like God, like the ⁹Angel of the Lord [who is] before them. **9** And in that day I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.

10 “I will pour out on the house of David and on the people of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace (unmerited favor) and supplication. And they will look at Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him as one who weeps bitterly over a firstborn. **11** In that day there shall be a great mourning in Jerusalem, like the mourning of [the city of] Hadadrimmon in the Valley of ¹²Megiddo [over beloved King ¹³Josiah]. **12** The land will mourn, every family by itself; the [royal] family of the house of David by itself and their wives by themselves; the family of the house of Nathan [David’s son] by itself and their wives by themselves; **13** the [priestly] family of the house of Levi by itself and their wives by themselves; the family of Shimei [grandson of Levi] by itself and their wives by themselves; **14** all the families that remain, each by itself, and their wives by themselves [each with an overwhelming individual regret for having blindly rejected their Messiah].

False Prophets Ashamed

13 “In that day a fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the people of Jerusalem for [cleansing from] sin and impurity.

2 “In that day,” declares the Lord of hosts, “I will cut off the names of the idols from the land, and they will no longer be remembered. I will also remove the [false] prophets and the unclean spirit from the land. **3** And if anyone still [appears as a prophet and falsely] prophesies, then his father and his mother who gave birth to him will say to him, ‘You shall not live, for you have spoken lies in the name of the Lord’; and his father and his mother who gave birth to him shall pierce him through when he prophesies. **4** And in that day the [false] prophets will each be ashamed of his vision when he prophesies, and they will not wear a hairy robe [of true prophets] in order to deceive, **5** but he will [deny his identity and] say, ‘I am no prophet. I work the ground, because a man sold me as a slave in my youth.’ **6** And one will say to him, ‘What are these ⁶wounds between your arms?’ Then he will answer, ‘Those wounds I received in the house of my friends.’

7

“Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd,
And against the Man, My Associate,”
Declares the Lord of hosts.
“Strike the Shepherd so that the sheep [of the flock] may be scattered;
And I will turn My hand *and* stretch it out against the little ones [of the flock].

"It will come about in all the land,"
 Declares the Lord,
 "Two parts in it will be cut off and perish,
 But the third will be left alive.

"And I will bring the third part through the fire,
 Refine them as silver is refined,
 And test them as gold is tested.
 They will call on My name,
 And I will listen *and* answer them;
 I will say, 'They are My people,'
 And they will say, 'The Lord is my God.'"

God Will Battle Jerusalem's Foes, He comes and Reigns

14 Behold, a day is coming for the Lord when the spoil taken from you (Jerusalem) will be divided in your midst. **2** For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle, and the city will be captured and the houses plundered and the women ravished; and half of the city will be exiled, but the rest of the people will not be cut off from the city. **3** Then the Lord will go forth and fight against those nations, as when He fights on a day of battle. **4** In that day His feet shall stand on the Mount of Olives, which lies before Jerusalem on the east; and the Mount of Olives will be split in half from the east to the west by a very large valley, and half of the mountain will move toward the north and half of it toward the south. **5** You will flee by the valley of My mountains, for the valley of the mountains will reach to Azel; and you will flee just as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Then the Lord my ¹God will come, and all the holy ones (believers, angels) with Him.

6 In that day there will be no light; the glorious ones (heavenly bodies) shall be darkened. **7** But **it will be a unique day which is known to the Lord—not day and not night, but at evening time there will be light.**

8 And in that day living waters will flow out from Jerusalem, half of them to the eastern sea (Dead Sea) and half of them to the western sea (the Mediterranean); it will be in summer as well as in winter.

God Will Be King over All

9 And the Lord shall be king over all the earth; in that day the Lord shall be *the only* one [worshiped], and His name *the only* one.

10 All the land will be changed into a plain from Geba to Rimmon, [the Rimmon that is] south of Jerusalem; but Jerusalem will rise and remain [lifted up] on its site from Benjamin's Gate to the place of the First Gate to the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel to the king's wine presses. **11** It will be inhabited, for there will no longer be a curse, for Jerusalem will dwell in security.

12 Now this will be the plague with which the Lord shall strike all the peoples that have warred against Jerusalem: Their flesh will rot while they stand on their feet, and their eyes will rot in their sockets, and their tongue will rot in their mouth. **13** In that day a great panic *and* dismay from the Lord will fall on them; and they will seize one another's hand, and the hand of the one will be raised against the

hand of the other. ¹⁴**Judah also will fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the surrounding nations will be gathered together—gold and silver and garments in great abundance.** ¹⁵So like this plague [on men] there will be the plague on the horses, mules, camels, donkeys, and all the livestock in those camps.

¹⁶**Then everyone who is left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and celebrate the Feast of Booths (Tabernacles).** ¹⁷**And it will be that whichever of the families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, there will be no rain on them.** ¹⁸If the family of Egypt does not go up [to Jerusalem] and present themselves, then no *rain will fall* on them. It will be the plague with which **the Lord will strike the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths (Tabernacles).** ¹⁹This will be the [consequent] punishment [for the sin] of Egypt, and the [consequent] punishment [for the sin] of all the nations that do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths (Tabernacles).

²⁰In that day there will be *written* on the little bells on the horses, “^{וְ}HOLY TO The Lord.” And the cooking pots in the Lord’s house will be [holy to the Lord] like the bowls before the altar. ²¹Every cooking pot in [all the houses in] Jerusalem and in Judah will be holy to the Lord of hosts, and all who sacrifice will come and take them and boil [their sacrifices] in them. And **in that day there will no longer be a Canaanite [that is, any godless or spiritually unclean person, whether Jew or Gentile] in the house of the Lord of hosts.**
